

REMEMBERING CODY PALANCE

City Slickers' Jack Palance will host the second annual Cody Palance Memorial Golf Classic, sponsored by Lane Furniture, at the Resort at Stallion Springs Resort in Tehachapi, California on Saturday, June 30, 2001.

Palance, who lost his only son, Cody, to cancer, is committed to raising funds to support cancer research. All proceeds from the golf classic will be donated to the Children's Center for Cancer & Blood Diseases at Children's Hospital Los Angeles. Last year's event generated \$28,000 and this year's goal is to double that amount.

City slickers will be treated to a routin', tootin' Wild West Show starring several of the cowboy characters from the hit movie *Tombstone*. Other highlights will include a historical gunfight reenactment, a mounted shooting demonstration, a live auction, and a prize drawing.

Buffalo Bill Cody will spin tall tales of his life and times during the barbecue dinner, and there will be other activities including a Jack Palance film festival as well as bowling, tennis, miniature golf, and horseback riding. A cowboy campfire will top off the evening, with guitars, cowboy poetry, and maybe even a song from old Curly hisself.
